AND UPON being satisfied that the application may be dealt with administratively without the need for an oral hearing

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1 The JOLs' fees for the period from 1 September 2021 to 28 February 2022 in the sum of US\$220,610 as set out in the Twenty-Sixth Affidavit of Simon Conway, be approved.
