- The JOLs' Remuneration Agreement, as exhibited to the Twenty-Seventh Affidavit of Simon Conway, be approved.
- The JOLs do apply for approval of their remuneration for the period from 1 September 2022 to 28 February 2023, such application to be heard on a date to be fixed.
- The costs of this Summons be costs in the official liquidation of the Company.
