

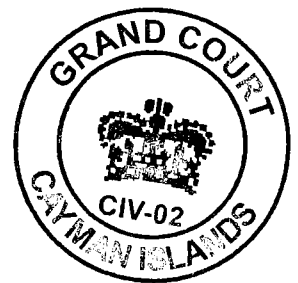

ORDER

UPON the hearing of the Summons dated 13 November 2019 of Messrs Simon Conway and Jess Shakespeare (the "JOLs") of Banco Privado Português (Cayman) Ltd (in official liquidation) (the "Company")

AND UPON reading the Twenty-First Affidavit of Simon Conway dated 13 November 2019, the Fourteenth Affidavit of Rachel Catherine Baxendale dated 22 November 2019, and the exhibits thereto


AND UPON being satisfied that the application may be dealt with administratively without the need for an oral hearing

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1 The JOLs' fees for the period from 1 March 2019 to 31 August 2019 in the sum of US\$267,741.50, as set out in the Twenty-First Affidavit of Simon Conway, be approved.
- 2 The JOLs' fees for the period from 1 September 2019 to 30 September 2019 in the sum of US\$65,276.00, as set out in the Twenty-First Affidavit of Simon Conway, be approved.

- 3 The JOLs' fees in the sum of US\$30,595.50 which were inadvertently omitted from prior periods between 1 September 2016 to 28 February 2019, as set out in the Twenty-First Affidavit of Simon Conway, be approved.
- 4 The JOLs do apply for approval of their remuneration for the period from 1 October 2019 to 28 February 2020, such application to be heard on a date to be fixed.
- 5 The costs of this Summons be costs in the official liquidation of the Company.
