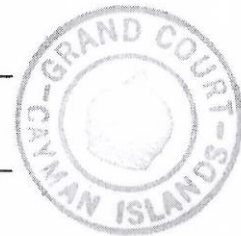

UPON hearing Counsel for Messrs David A.K. Walker and Ian D Stokoe, the official liquidators of Banco Privado Portugues (Cayman) Ltd (in official liquidation) (the "JOLs" and the "Company" respectively) and upon their Summons dated 24 March 2014 as it relates to their remuneration for the period from 1 September 2013 to 31 January 2014

AND UPON reading the Second Affidavit of Simon Conway sworn on 20 March 2014 and filed on behalf of the JOLs


IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1 The JOLs' fees for the period from 1 September 2013 to 31 January 2014 in the sums of US\$210,386.00 and EUR14,130.00 are hereby approved..
- 2 The remuneration agreement dated 28 March 2014 (a copy of which is annexed hereto) is hereby approved and shall apply for a period of two years ended 31 December 2015.
- 3 The JOLs shall apply for approval of their remuneration for the period from 1 February 2014 to 31 July 2014, such application to be heard on 17 October 2014.

4 The costs of this application shall be paid out of the Company's assets as an expense of the liquidation.
